VTEC Monitoring

- EFSA is providing data on VTEC but problems with standardization still exist
- EFSA has provided a first opinion on VTEC reporting and monitoring
- Another EFSA working group on monitoring is about to be established

VTEC are quite different from salmonella and campylobacter





VTEC detection: standardization of methods

- CEN VTEC group progressed with the PCR method and a draft will be available next spring!!
- a CEN validation study of the standard horizontal method for *E. coli* O157 EN/ISO 16654 has been prepared and is about to start with 13 NRLs involved in the study (waiting for money)
- It could also be used for a first assessment of some aspects of the PCR method





VTEC detection: standardization of methods

 We also are quite ahead with a PCR scheme for VT gene typing !!!!

Agreement with human labs





NRLs Activities

 Many NRLs already involved in monitoring-like activities





VTEC Data Base

 The DB will begin to collect data soon: next year we'll see the results

- Memorandum of understanding among participants on data usage
- Harmonization with the EFSA data collection
- Harmonization with the Enter-Net human Databases (ECDC)





1st Ring Trial on VTEC identification

Most NRLs who participated in the test performed well in identifying d typing VTEC

The number of NRLs involved in the proficiency testing must increase!!





2008 - Proficiency testing

- CEN validation study of the standard horizontal method for *E. coli* O157 EN/ISO 16654 for 13 NRLs
- (but could be extended to other NRLs with CRL funds as a proficiency testing??)
- 2nd Ring Trial on VTEC identification and typing





Other activities 2008

Assistance to NRLs:

- Provision of methods, standard operating procedures, reference strains.
- -short visits of NRL staff for individual training

- Phagetyping of *E.coli* O157 at the CRL by mid 2008!
- Move the annual workshop from CRL to other NRLs (verify economic and administrative feasibility)
