O-serogrouping (verification)

Surveillance and surveys of food and animals for VTEC and O157

Development of real-time PCR based detection assays

Research in regulation of VT expression and VT cytotoxicity

Participate in outbreak investigations

Advising authorities and local laboratories about VTEC
