



Virological surveillance

RespiVirNet

Report for week 46/2023
(13th – 19th November 2023)

Summary

The present report summarizes the results obtained in the context of the virological surveillance activities in Italy, coordinated by the National Influenza Centre (NIC) laboratory at ISS, in collaboration with a network of 24 regional influenza laboratories (RespiVirNet).

During the forty-sixth week of 2023 (**week 46/2023**), virological surveillance reported a low influenza virus circulation in Italy. In particular, **808** clinical specimens were received by the RespiVirNet network laboratories and **21 (2.6%)** resulted positive for influenza, all belonging to influenza type **A** (18 were **H1N1pdm09**, 2 were **H3N2** and 1 not yet subtyped)

Among the above analyzed samples, 67 (8.3%) resulted **SARS-CoV-2**, 34 (4.2%) **RSV** and the other 207 were attributed to other respiratory viruses, in particular 152 Rhinoviruses, 28 Adenoviruses, 15 Parainfluenza viruses, 9 human Coronaviruses (not SARS-CoV-2) and 3 Metapneumoviruses.
