

Trends in Trichinella testing in Sweden

 From July 2014 Sweden applies reduced *Trichinella* testing of pigs from holdings with controlled housing conditions. Consequently, the total number of pigs tested decreased. However, since 2017 the number increasing again.



 The Swedish wild boar population is steadily expanding. The estimated proportion of hunted boars tested for Trichinella increased from 50% in 2007 to more than 90% in 2017. Surprisingly, it appears to decline in 2018.



 Since 2017 Trichinella testing is done at 5 only five laboratories, none of them is situated at an abattoir.
