

AGLIERI Vincenzo



Vincenzo Aglieri entered the Italian Naval Academy in 1983 as a first-class cadet of the 16th A.S.M.I. course. After earning a degree in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Pisa, he was commissioned as an Ensign (Sottotenente di Vascello) in 1990.

He served as Head of the Medical Department aboard Italian frigate Aliseo until November 1992. In 1996, he obtained a specialization in Radiology from the Polytechnic University of Marche and was assigned to Marinfarm Augusta as Head of the Radiology Department.

In 1998, he was assigned to Marinfarm Roma, where he held the dual role of Radiology Department Officer and member of the 2nd Military Hospital Medical Board. In the same year, he completed a temporary deployment aboard Italian patrol vessel Tremiti, participating in

COMGRUPNAV 28 operations based in Durrës.

Between 2004 and 2008, he served in several positions: in 2004 as Head of the Radiology Department of the Medical Service of Maridist Roma; in 2006 as Head of the Medical Service of the same command, also performing deputy director duties; and finally in 2008 as Head of the 2nd Training Section of the 1st Office at Marispesan, while continuing to oversee the radiology service of Maridist Roma.

In 2010, he took part in Operation White Crane aboard Italian aircraft carrier Cavour, providing assistance to the population of Haiti following the earthquake. Four years later, in 2014, he assumed command of the Rome Garrison Infirmary and leadership of the Office of the Medical Coordinator of Maricapitale. In 2018, he attended the 69th I.A.S.D. course. In 2021, he was promoted to Rear Admiral and appointed President of the Central Medical Board of Marispesan.

In September 2021, he assumed the position of Head of the Medical Office of CINCPNAV and Medical Advisor to the Commander in Chief. In this role, in November 2023, he coordinated and directed aboard ITS Vulcano the activation of the Role 2 medical facility deployed in support of the civilian population of Gaza Strip as part of Operation Levante.

From January 1st 2025, he assumed the position of Deputy Inspector of Health at Marispesan, and on May 23th 2025 he was promoted to Admiral Inspector, taking up the appointment as Chief of the Medical Corps.

He currently serves as Inspector of Health and Chief of the Medical Corps of the Italian Navy.
