

Enrico Alleva (Rome, 1953) ethologist, founder of the Behavioral Sciences and Mental Health Center at Istituto Superiore di Sanità, where he worked from 1979 to 2018. After obtaining his degree in Biological sciences at “Sapienza” University of Rome he specialized in animal behaviour at Scuola Normale Superiore of Pisa. He is member of the Italian Health Council, Accademia Nazionale Lincei, Accademia Scienze Bologna and Medical Academy of Rome. He was Vicepresident of the Italian Health Council, President of Stazione Zoologica Anton Dohrn of Naples (2011-2013), of the Scientific and Technical Committee of the Italian Space Agency (ASI) and of the Italian Federation of Environmental and Natural Sciences (FISNA). The Web of Science lists over 320 articles in peer-reviewed journals with h-index of 64.
