

## **Bio Campitiello in inglese**

Maria Rosaria Campitiello, MD, PhD, is Head of the Department of Prevention, Research and Health Emergencies at the Italian Ministry of Health. She is a Medical Director of the National Health Service and a specialist in Gynecology and Obstetrics, with extensive experience in reproductive medicine, public health, healthcare organization, and health policy.

She graduated in Medicine and Surgery in 2009 and completed her specialization in Gynecology and Obstetrics in 2015. She further advanced her training in reproductive medicine through a Level II Master's degree in Assisted Fertilization Techniques and a PhD from the University of Valencia. She also completed an international fellowship at the Valencian Institute of Infertility, where she developed expertise in medically assisted reproduction and translational clinical research.

Over the years, she has held senior clinical and management positions in medically assisted reproduction centers and served as Medical Director at the Salerno Local Health Authority. She has also contributed to regional healthcare planning and scientific coordination activities for the Campania Region.

Since 2022, she has pursued an institutional career within the Italian Ministry of Health, serving first at the General Directorate of Health Prevention and subsequently at the Cabinet Office, where she held the positions of Cabinet Director and Head of the Minister's Technical Secretariat. Since June 2024, she has led the Department of Prevention, Research and Health Emergencies, with activities focused on prevention strategies, epidemiological surveillance, health system strengthening, and management of public health emergencies.
