

Prof. Marco Giovine is Full Professor of Molecular Biology at the University of Genoa (DISTAV). His research activity focuses on marine molecular biology and marine biotechnology, with particular attention to marine biomaterials.

His work investigates marine organisms, particularly sponges, as model systems for both fundamental biological processes and the development of bioinspired solutions with potential applications in regenerative medicine and environmental sustainability. He has authored over 80 peer-reviewed publications, is co-inventor of several patents, and has contributed to the establishment of university spin-offs, supporting innovation and knowledge transfer.

Prof. Giovine directed the Sea Study Centre of the University of Genoa until 2025 and continues to be actively involved in its activities, contributing to the promotion of interdisciplinary approaches and collaborative initiatives in the field of marine research. He is also a member of the PhD Board in Marine Sciences and Technologies.
