Dr. Riyong Kim is Head of Department, Environment and Sustainability at the European Environment Agency, responsible for the strategic development of the Agency's work in the areas of environment and human health, freshwater and marine ecosystems, biodiversity and nature, and sustainability transitions, which encompasses systemic change, foresight, just transition and economics and finance. The Department also produces the 5-year flagship report on Europe's environment, works with EEA member countries and the European Commission to support reporting, data, indicators and knowledge in the areas of environment and sustainability, and manages networking activities targeting the EEA's key stakeholders.

Prior to joining EEA, Riyong led the programme on Decision Metrics and Finance at EIT Climate KIC, working on systems innovation to tackle short-termism and mainstream climate in financial markets in the EU. She has also worked in global environmental and climate policy with UN Environment and UNFCCC, UN FAO, CIFOR, World Bank PROFOR, and for the regional ENPI-FLEG program with IUCN. Riyong has an interdisciplinary background in environmental science (B.A, B.Sc., M.Sc.) and Ph.D. In Natural Resource Economics from University of Copenhagen, Denmark. She started her career leading international development efforts in Timor Leste and Aceh, Indonesia, with the Australian Labour Unions, and brings experience from the Brazilian Amazon, and Democratic Republic of Congo, as well as EU and CEE countries.
