

RONDININI Lorenzo



Lorenzo Rondinini joined the Italian Navy in 1986 as a cadet of the 19th A.S.M.I. Course at the Italian Naval Academy. After graduating with honors in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Pisa in 1993, he continued his education by obtaining a specialization diploma in Cardiology from the same university in 2001. In the following years, he earned several professional qualifications, including the national certification in basic echocardiography in 2004, qualification as a BLS-D instructor in the same year, and qualification as a PTC instructor in 2010. Since 2010, he has been Director of the Italian Navy's BLS-D and PTC IRC Training Center in La Spezia.

During his training period, he completed practical internships at the Naval Military Hospital of La Spezia and the "Spedali Riuniti" Hospital in Livorno. In 1994, he attended a training course in hyperbaric chamber medical assistance at the COMSUBIN Teseo Tesei. Following the medical application course, he was commissioned as a Medical Sub-Lieutenant and began his operational assignment as Head of the Medical Department aboard the guided missile cruiser Italian cruiser Vittorio Veneto.

Throughout his career, he has held numerous appointments, including Medical Officer at the Naval Military Hospital of La Spezia and subsequently at the infirmary of the Naval Academy in Livorno. From 2001 to 2004, he served as Head of the Medical Department and Garrison Medical Officer at the Italian Navy Training and Recruitment Center in La Spezia, a position he combined with duties as a cardiologist at the local Naval Military Hospital. He subsequently held positions of increasing responsibility in cardiology services and healthcare management, eventually becoming Head of the Cardiology Department at the Military Department of Forensic Medicine in La Spezia in 2016.

From 2013 to 2020, he held leadership roles in the management of military hospital medical boards and later served as Director of the Military Department of Forensic Medicine and Medical Coordinator of the Northern Maritime Command. He also participated in international peacekeeping missions, including Operation Leonte in Lebanon and Operation Alba 2 in Albania.

During the COVID-19 pandemic emergency, he served as Regional Coordinating Officer for Liguria. From 2020 to 2022, he held the position of Head of the Medical Training Office at the Naval Academy, followed by the appointment as Head of the 2nd Office of the Italian Navy Health Inspectorate.

Rear Admiral Rondinini currently serves as Deputy Inspector of Health of the Italian Navy.
